

Good Morning,

We have been receiving quite a few of the same questions regarding the waitlist, so here is some more information:

When will we know if we get into the tournament?

- Teams are moved from the waitlist as other teams drop from the tournament. We have absolutely no way of knowing if or when teams will drop and therefore cannot tell when teams would potentially be moved from the waitlist.
- We have had teams travel to the event without a spot in the tournament. Some have gotten in when other teams no-showed registration, more have not gotten into the event. If a team does not show up to the tournament, we would contact teams in the order of the waitlist and the first one available (whether already at the tournament or within driving distance) would be admitted to the event at that point.

If we switch divisions are we more likely to get into the tournament?

- No. All divisions are currently full with a waitlist. If a DII or DIII team drops, that spot would be filled by a team already accepted into the tournament in I/IAA/IAAA and then a team would be moved into that spot in I/IAA/IAAA from the waitlist.

Is there anything we can do to move up the waitlist?

- No. The waitlist is ordered based on teams completing registration and we will accept teams in that order as teams drop from the tournament.

Can NCVF expand the tournament?

- We are exploring options to fit a few more teams into the event (potentially up to 12 total split between the men/women) and will let you know as soon as we can if we are able to do so. This would require completely reworking the schedule for Saturday, pushing back brackets, changing championship matches, adding/changing divisions, etc., so it is a very time intensive project, but we're working as quickly as we can to see if there is any way to do so.
- We are exploring larger and/or additional facilities for future years, but most of these facilities are booked several years out so it was not possible to add them this year after registration filled.
